strong connection to at least one global context.

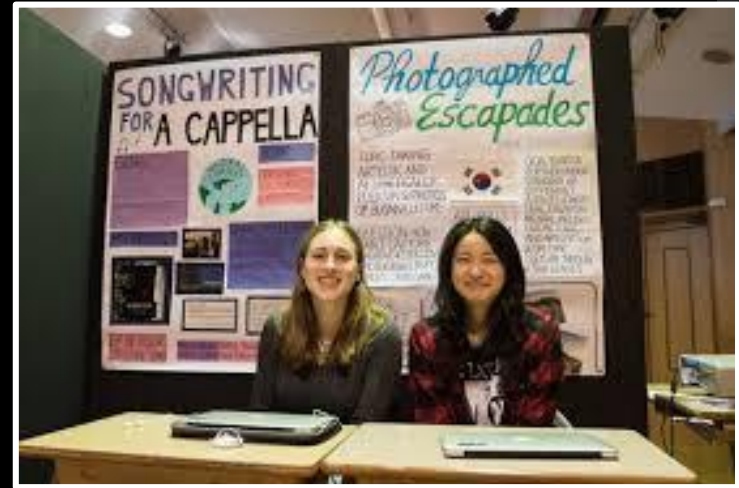
The personal project is the opportunity for your child to do what he/she wants to do, to show the skills they have developed over the years while in the Middle Years Programme (MYP). The personal project holds a special importance in the MYP, as it is the culminating event completed in the final year of the program - 10th grade.

Personal Project Expectations

Students have selected a topic that is researchable, challenging, and has meaning for them.

Personal project requirements

- The process journal
- The product/outcome (there must be proof)
- The report
- The presentation of the Personal Project at Lamar's Personal Project Showcase
